Re: Year 11 Leavers Information

Expectations Throughout the Exam Season

The GCSE examinations begin on Thursday 1st May and officially finish on Wednesday 25th June.

Throughout the exam season until the afternoon of 13th June, all students are expected to attend school and lessons as normal in full school uniform (please see the section 'Study Leave' for more information). The existing Positive Discipline Policy will also continue to be implemented until the end of the exam season. Students will continue to be awarded reward stamps and points and, for every 50 points they gain, a ticket will be entered into the leavers' assembly reward draw with first prize being a £50 voucher.

If your child's subject still has timetabled examinations, teachers will lead normal lessons; but, if their subject has completed all examination components, teachers will help your child to engage in silent study. All students must carry suitable revision resources (e.g., revision guides) with them to all lessons and will not be permitted to leave their lessons to seek resources from their other teachers. To help, all students have already been given revision guides for their core subjects and will be given additional revision resources over the next couple of weeks.

Breakfast Before School

From Thursday 8th May, breakfast will be available to all Year 11 students from 7:45am in the dining room. An assortment of cereals and toast will be available to students at no charge. This offer will run every morning until 17th June. Students can also use this time as an opportunity for any last-minute revision before their morning exam.

Afternoon Exams

Please note that some afternoon exams may run past 3:10pm. We recommend that an alternative method for getting home is organised if your child usually relies on the school bus. This will be the case for students studying Enterprise whose exam on 21st May will not finish until 4:30pm.

Exam Clashes

On 21st May, there is an exam clash between Religious Studies and Enterprise. It is not within our jurisdiction to rearrange the examinations. All students will complete the Religious Studies exam and those who study Enterprise will remain in the exam hall and complete their second exam after a short, supervised break.



Contingency Sessions

In the unlikely event of a national or local disruption to the examinations, the awarding bodies have designated the afternoon of Wednesday 11th June, and all day on Wednesday 25th June 2025 as 'contingency days'. It is vital that all students remain available for these times.

Study Leave

From 12:35pm on Friday 13th June, Year 11 students are only required to come into school to take their GCSE examinations, as per the exams schedule within this letter. Prior to this, students are expected to attend school and lessons as previously explained. More information regarding our decision around this will be shared with students in their assembly this morning.

From Monday 16th June, all students entering the school site must still wear their full uniform. All students must be familiar with their exam schedule and ensure they **arrive at school at least 30 minutes before the exam is due to start**. For all morning exams, students will go straight to the main hall at 8:50am for an exam booster. For all afternoon exams, students should go to the main hall at 12:15pm for their exam booster. This will be followed by lunch between 12:35pm and 1:05pm and then their exam. At the end of all exams, students will be dismissed from the exam hall and leave the school site, or, in the case of morning exams, they may re-enter school via reception and sign in.

A number of classrooms will be available for Year 11 students to use as silent study areas from lunch time on Friday 13th June. Year 11 students who do not have an exam but who wish to utilise the classrooms as somewhere quiet to revise are very welcome to attend. We are also able to continue to offer a number of teacher-led revision sessions in preparation for the remaining exams and encourage all students to attend. Students utilising the quiet study areas should bring their own revision materials and will not be allowed to go and seek resources from their teachers. When using the study areas or attending a teacher-led revision session, students will enter school through reception, signing in and out each time.

Year 11 Leavers Celebration - Wednesday 18th June

We would like to invite all students into school on Wednesday 18th June for a special leavers' celebration morning. (Please note, this is a student-only event.)

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Students are expected to attend their celebration morning in full school uniform. As per the above schedule, students will have the opportunity to take photographs and sign shirts, but **students must bring a spare shirt with them for this purpose.**

Uniform and Revision Guide Donations

Please send uniform items with your child and ask them to leave their donations with a member of staff or drop these off in reception. School Resources and Lockers

Should your child have any school resources, such as library books, subject textbooks, subject specific resources or a school laptop, please return these before the day of their last exam. Please also remind your child to empty their locker before the end of Friday 13th June.

ParentPay

Please check your child's ParentPay account to ensure any outstanding balances are paid.

Year 11 Prom

The Year 11 Prom will be an excellent opportunity for all our students to celebrate their time at All Saints. As per our November letter, the Prom will take place on Friday, 20th June at The John Smiths Stadium. The evening starts at 6:30pm and will finish promptly at 11pm.

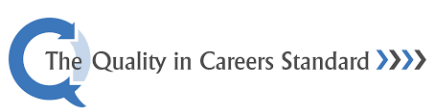
A reminder that the full amount of £30 must be paid via ParentPay by end of today, Friday 25th April 2025.

We reserve the right to refuse entry to the Prom to any student who makes a serious breach of our Positive Discipline Policy between the initial letter in November and the Prom. Please note, a refund will not be provided in this instance.

Transportation to and from the event needs to be organised by parents/carers – please ensure your child is collected on time at the end of the evening, at 11pm. The Prom will be alcohol-free. **Any student who appears to be under the influence of alcohol will be refused entry to the Prom and any student found bringing alcohol into the Prom will be asked to leave.**

Results Day

We will be open on **Thursday, 21st August 2025 between 9am and 10.30am** for the distribution of examination results. If your child is on holiday or is unable to come to college to collect their results, their results will be posted to their home address. Results cannot be posted before publication day. If they wish for someone else to come into school and collect their results on their behalf, they should send the name of the person by email to examinations@aschc.com, before the end of the exams. The person collecting the results must bring a form of ID with them.
