## Year 11 Leavers Information

### Expectations Throughout the Exam Season

The GCSE examinations begin on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May, and officially finish on 24<sup>th</sup> June 2026.

Throughout the exam season, until the afternoon of Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> June, all students are expected to attend school and lessons as normal in full school uniform (please see the section entitled 'Study Leave' for more information). The existing Positive Discipline Policy will also continue to be implemented until the end of the exam season. Students will continue to be awarded reward stamps and points and, for every 50 points they gain, a ticket will be entered into the leavers' assembly reward draw with first prize being a £50 voucher.

If your child's subject still has timetabled examinations, teachers will lead normal lessons; but, if their subject has concluded in all examination components, teachers will help your child to engage in self-study. All students must carry suitable revision resources (e.g., revision guides) with them to all lessons and will not be permitted to leave their lessons to seek resources from their other teachers. To help, all students have already been given revision guides for their core subjects and will be given additional revision resources over the next couple of weeks.

### Breakfast Before School

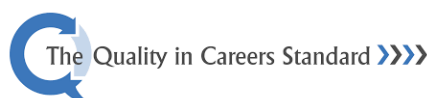
From Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May, breakfast will be available to all Year 11 students from 8am in the dining room. An assortment of cereals and toast will be available to students at no charge. This offer will run every morning until 8<sup>th</sup> June. Students can also use this time as an opportunity for any last-minute revision before their morning exam.

### Afternoon Exams

Please note that some afternoon exams for some students may run past 3:20pm. If this is the case for your child, we recommend that an alternative method for getting home is organised if your child usually relies on the school bus.

### Contingency Day

In the unlikely event of a national or local disruption to the examinations, the awarding bodies have designated Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> June as a 'contingency day'. **It is vital that all students remain available on this day.**

## Study Leave

From Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June, Year 11 students are only required to come into school to take their GCSE examinations, as per the exams schedule within this letter. Prior to this, students are expected to attend school and lessons as previously explained.

From the 9<sup>th</sup> June, all students entering the school site must still wear their full uniform. All students must be familiar with their exam schedule and ensure they **arrive at school at least 30 minutes before the exam is due to start**. For all morning exams, students will go straight to the main hall at 8:50am for an exam booster. For all afternoon exams, students should go to the main hall at **12:55pm** for their exam booster session. At the end of all exams, students will be dismissed from the exam hall and leave the school site, or, in the case of morning exams, they may re-enter school via reception and sign in.

A number of classrooms will be available for Year 11 students to use as quiet study areas from Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup> June. Year 11 students who do not have an exam but who wish to utilise the classrooms as somewhere quiet to revise are very welcome to attend. We are also able to continue to offer a number of teacher-led revision sessions in preparation for the remaining exams and encourage all students to attend. Students utilising the quiet study areas should bring their own revision materials and will not be allowed to go and seek resources from their teachers. When using the study areas or attending a teacher-led revision session, students will enter school through reception, signing in and out each time.

## Year 11 Leavers Celebration - Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June

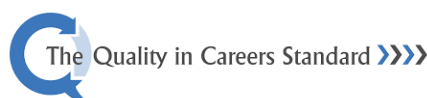
We would like to invite all students into school on Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> June, for a special leavers' celebration morning. (Please note, this is a student-only event.)

Time	Event
10am	Students enter via the main reception and go straight to the main hall for registration.
10:30am	Mass in the main hall led by Fr. John.
11:10am – 11:20am	Comfort break.
11:20am – 12:10pm	Leavers assembly in the main hall.
12:10pm – 12:40pm	Shirt signing and photos in the dining room and yard. Students will be able to leave site from 12:35pm.

Students are expected to attend their celebration morning in full school uniform. As per the above schedule, students will have the opportunity to take photographs and sign shirts, but **students must bring a spare shirt with them for this purpose**.

## Uniform and Revision Guide Donations

On Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> June, and on Results Day, we will be collecting donations of uniform items, including PE kit, that are in good condition and can be repurposed to benefit other students in our school community. Please send uniform items with your child and ask them to leave their





donations with a member of staff or drop these off in reception. We also welcome donations of revision guides and any resources that may be of use to our current Year 10 students. We thank you in advance for your kind generosity.

## School Resources and Lockers

Should your child have any school resources, such as library books, subject textbooks, subject specific resources or a school laptop, please ensure that these are returned before the day of their last exam. Please also remind your child to empty their locker before the end of Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> June.

Please check your child's ParentPay account to ensure any outstanding balances are paid.

## Year 11 Prom

The Year 11 Prom will be an excellent opportunity for all our students to celebrate their time at All Saints. As per our December letter, the Prom will take place on Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> June, at the Accu Stadium in Huddersfield. The evening starts at 6:30pm and will finish promptly at 11pm.

**A reminder that the full amount of £34 must be paid via ParentPay by the end of Thursday, 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026.**

We reserve the right to refuse entry to the Prom to any student who makes a serious breach of our Positive Discipline Policy between the initial letter in December and the Prom. Please note, a refund will not be provided in this instance.

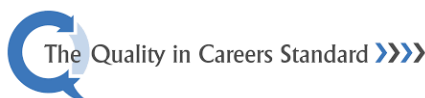

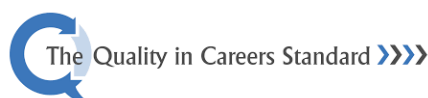
